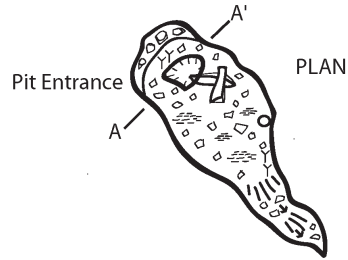

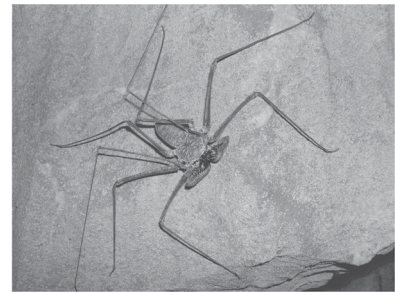
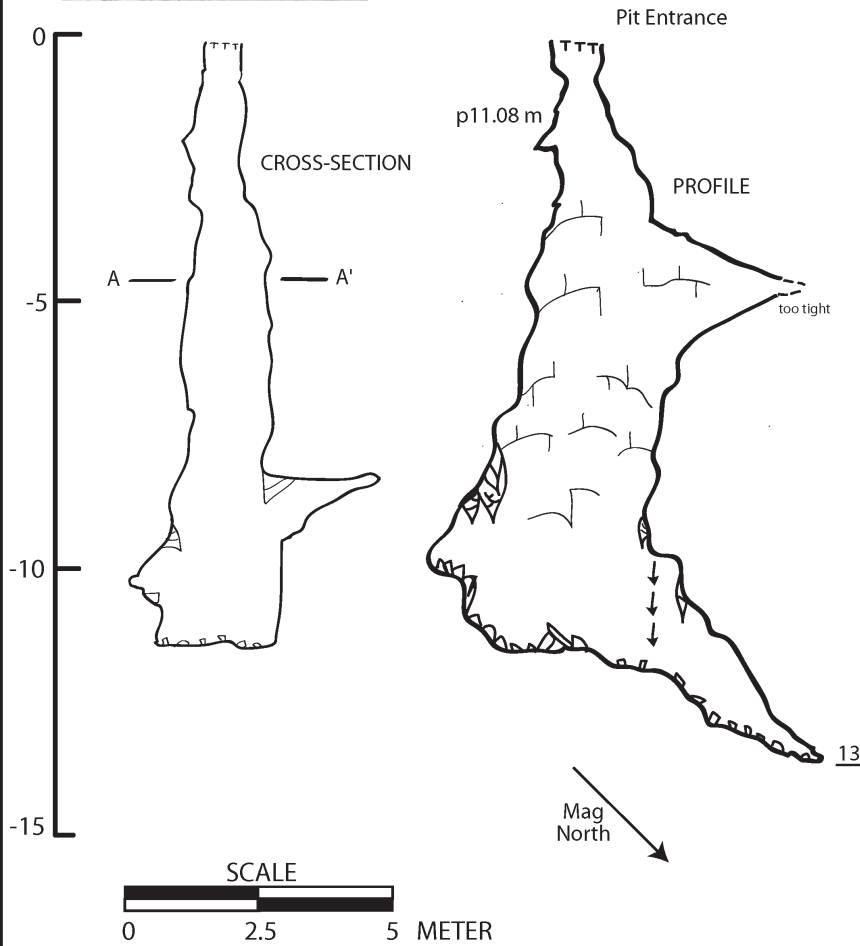
James, descending through tight entrance



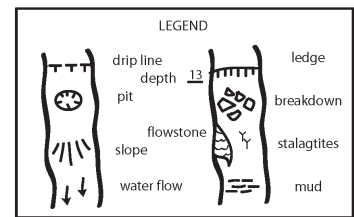
Entrance in a cluster of small trees & shrubs, inbetween fields of corn, sugar cane, and grazing animals; Rig to nearby tree
