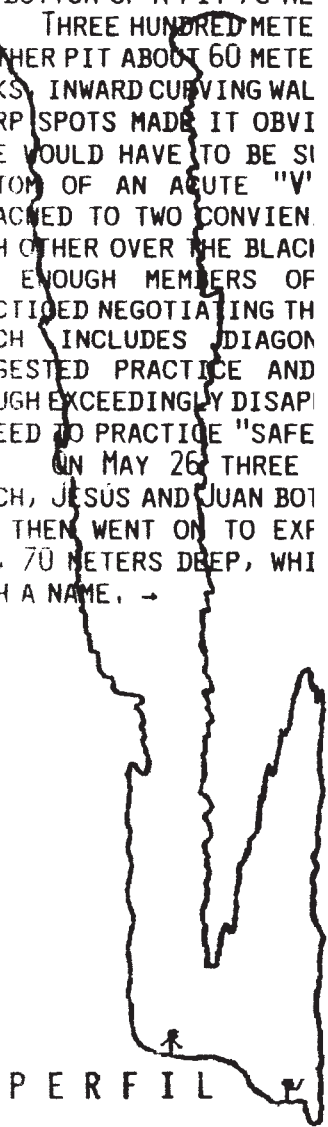


THE BOTTOM OF A PIT 70 ME
